This silver kinetic necklace has nine vanes attached to a circular piece in the centre and a detachable neck wire. Kinetic means moving or moveable. It was made by Kathleen Thomson during her Postgraduate Diploma year at Duncan of Jordanstone College of Art, Dundee. Hallmarked in London, it has the optional Silver Jubilee mark of 1977.

Kathleen Thomson (b.1953) studied at Duncan of Jordanstone College of Art, Dundee from 1972 until 1976. Thereafter she set up a workshop in Auchterarder, Perthshire. In 1982 she opened the Jewellery Workshop at 262 High Street, Perth.
